1. Many of you are probably following the budget crisis facing FCPS. For those of you who are not familiar with the problems, please check out the details at [www.fcps.edu](http://www.fcps.edu). There is a \$176 million shortfall for the next budget year. This will greatly impact all of our schools. On the website click on the "Potential Programs and Service Reductions" link to see the list of items that will be discussed at the Budget Community Dialogue meetings. I strongly urge our community to attend these meetings and stay in touch with the budget process.

2. In these times of broad economic difficulty it is even more important that the PTA fundraising efforts be supported so we can achieve our goal of supporting the best and highest quality of education for our children at Lees Corner. Unfortunately at the time when it is most needed our donation drive has all but come to a complete stop. As I've said, we have had an incredibly generous show of support from a small percentage of our families. We are very thankful for that. Again, if you happen to be one of the 335 families that have not made their donation yet – it's not too late, it's never too late. We are still suggesting \$75 if you have one child at Lees Corner and \$100 if you have two or more. Please remember that this is only a suggested amount. We understand that some families are able to do more and some less; we just ask that you do what you can. You should have received a second request letter and envelope in your oldest child's Wednesday folder. We truly appreciate your returning them with whatever you are able to donate.

Finally, I must say that I am encouraged by all the new faces that are getting involved in the PTA. It is refreshing for those of us that have been around for a while to see new faces with new ideas!

## Inclement Weather

With the cold weather here, it's time to review the county's plans for schools in the event of inclement weather (or other emergency situations). It may be necessary to close schools for **the entire day**, to **open schools two hours late**, or to **close schools two hours early** due to snow, ice, or other conditions making it dangerous for our children to get to school. Parents are urged to make arrangements now for the care of their children when schedule changes are made (and to provide for the rare situation when it is necessary to close an individual school because of a power failure or other circumstances). Children should know where to go or what to do if a parent will not be or is not home.

As soon as a decision is made to implement one of these changes, the information will be posted on **FCPS cable Channel 21** and a message will be placed on our web site - [www.fcps.edu](http://www.fcps.edu). E-mail notifications will be made through our **Keep in Touch (KIT)** system. Parents, please make sure to have your contact information updated on your child's emergency form at school. Our KIT system pulls information from our Student Information System. The news will also be carried by radio and television

stations, which are notified as quickly as possible after a decision is made. Please do not phone individual schools or one of the stations for this information.

The try to make a decision by 4:30 a.m. when schools will be closed all day or will open two hours late. This give so that the public announcement can be posted and reach all media outlets by 5:00 a.m. On some occasions, it is not possible to make these time frames as weather can change unexpectedly. On some other occasions, the school system has been able to make a scheduling decision the day before so that parents, staff members, and students know what will happen the following day. This usually happens when precipitation is already on the ground and the temperatures are such that the precipitation on the ground is frozen or will refreeze.
